# FOR DIVE AGAINST DEBRIS SURVEY DIVERS

Use this checklist to remember everything you need for a successful Dive Against Debris survey.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** All survey divers should read the **Dive Against Debris Survey Guide** before taking part in survey activities. The Survey Guide contains important information on choosing a survey site, enjoying a safe survey dive and accurately reporting data.

## **Getting Ready**

- □ Receive permission to dive at your Survey Site (if required)
- □ Check weather/tide/current conditions
- □ Safety/first aid equipment
- □ Dive flags
- Emergency Assistance Plan
- □ Paperwork (includes **Dive Against Debris Liability Release**)
- □ All survey divers have read the **Dive Against Debris Survey Guide**
- Plan you dive and dive your plan

### **Gear Requirements and Recommendations**

- Mesh bags
- □ Dive tool/knife
- Gloves (if permitted at your survey location)
- □ Strong scissors to cut fishing line and light nets
- GPS (or use the online point-and-click map)
- Underwater camera
- □ Sharps container
- □ Blank slate and pencil
- □ Water, snacks, sunscreen, hat, exposure protection

### **Recording Data**

- □ Weighing scales
- □ Printed copies of the Dive Against Debris Data Card
- □ Marine Debris Identification Guide for reference
- Dive Against Debris Survey Guide for reference
- $\hfill\square$  Organised recycling and disposal of rubbish
